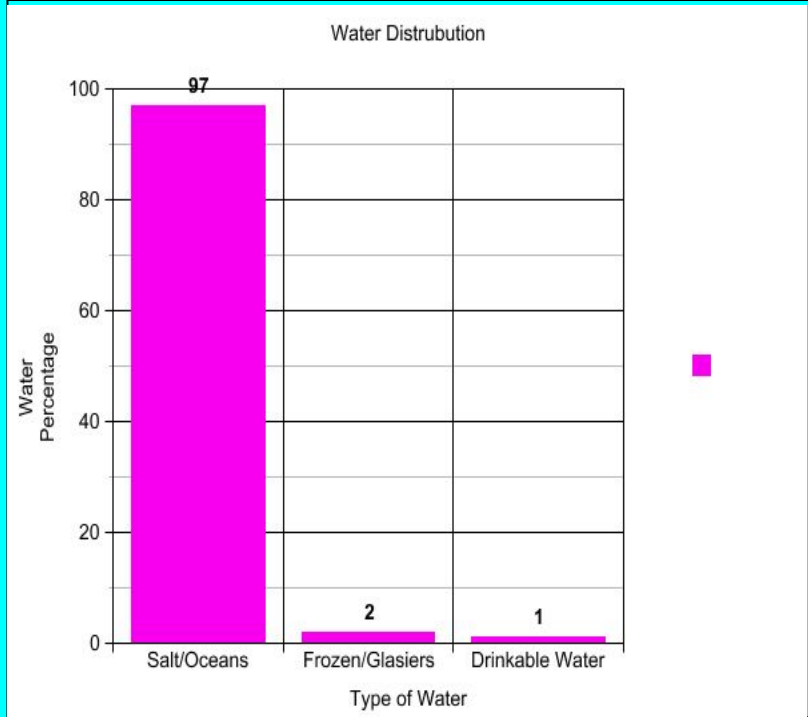


Pollution
