I am sorry for the delay. I lost track of time yesterday.

Here is what we are thinking for activities that we will facilitate

Locations- Feel free to make a schedule that works for your school and what you might have in mind as well. The Science room would be great to use for grades 3-5. We could do the seed balls outside. PreK and K could be a mix of inside and outside or using the outdoor classroom. Let us know what you think might work best and we will plan accordingly.

Whole School- We would love to create a board that is a pledge to the Earth. This could be really simple. We have brown craft paper to display. Everyone would be given time to write a promise or pledge. We can share activities and ideas with each group when we meet.

Harvest Table- We will have a farm partner come and set up a table with farm produce. This can be in addition to the programming we provide.

Prek-K- Worms are Wonderful- We will discuss worms and the amazing role they play in our ecosystem. Students will observe worms and be worm detectives. We will discuss composting. Young students will then get time to create bug hotels.

1st-2nd- Sowing Seeds- Students will make seed balls and discuss promoting wildlife. We will discuss the history of Earth day.

3rd-5th- Urban Garden Design- Each student will plant a lettuce or herb seedling to take home. Students will be given recipes for their chosen plant and then create their own vision of an urban garden after thoughtful discussion.
