Thank you for signing up for free weekly recycling collection from the Baltimore City Department of Public Works (DPW) for the 2024-2025 school year. We are pleased to have you participate in this program and to partner with you to reduce, reuse and, recycle with our city's youth!

Collection Details:

- **Your school: Charles Carroll Barrister**
- **Your collection day: Thursday – Recycling Bins (Curbside Collection)**
- **Your first collection day: 9/19/2024**

Additional Information:

- Place recycling at your designated collection point before 7 am on your collection day.
- Ensure that no vehicles are blocking access to the recycling for the duration of your collection day. If your recycling is inaccessible, DPW will not be able to service your recycling until your next collection day.
- If there is no recycling outside for three consecutive weeks, DPW will stop visiting your school and a representative from BCPSS will notify you of this change.
- There will be a reenrollment period between the second and third quarters for schools who were removed from the program.
- For schools removed after the start of the third quarter, they will not receive collection for the remainder of the school year. They will be able to sign up for summer school recycling when the time comes.
- Recycling may be placed in any labeled container, but **NOT** in plastic bags.

- All cardboard boxes must be flattened.
- On City Schools and Baltimore City holidays, DPW will not collect recycling.
- If your recycling is not collected by 2 pm on your collection day, please submit a ticket to **311 via web, app, or phone call**. 311 instructions [here](#). DPW is tracking missed collections closely and will be in communication with Gaby Vinas. She will be your point of contact for updates on rectifying the missed collection. DPW has 5 business days to remediate any collections that were missed due to DPW error. If your school does not set the recycling out in time, it will be collected on the next regularly scheduled collection day.
