If you don't recycle them they will just stay there in a Landfill

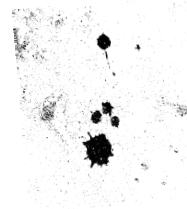
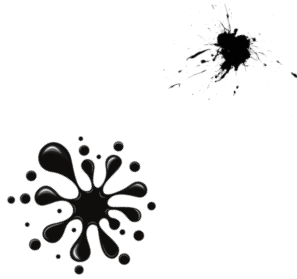
It reduce waste when you recycle them

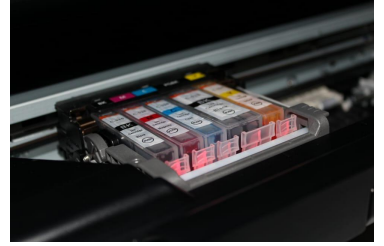
This is what will happen if you don't recycle them
