Terrapin Facts

Diamondback terrapins are social creatures and are often seen basking together during the day. At night they rest in their burrows in the mud at low tide. These turtles spend the majority of their life in water, however, they do leave the water to bask and lay eggs.

Adult Diamondback terrapins hibernate in the colder months in most of their range, in the mud of creeks and marshes.
