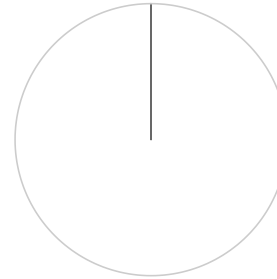

SUBMITTED SHORT ANSWERS

Question	How do the ideas of the talent search finalists support the main idea of the text?
Example	<i>Student answers will vary.</i> Students should explain that each of the ideas provided by the finalists of Regeneron Science Talent Search support the main idea that there could be many ways to slow down climate change if people work together. Each of the ideas presented by the finalists show that people working together can have an impact on the overall problem of climate change. Some finalists suggest planting trees (paragraph 4) and others would ask the government to work with businesses to limit the burning of fossil fuels (paragraph 8). Both of these ideas involve people working together. Because the challenge of climate change is so large, "we need to collaborate" (paragraph 12). Ana Humphrey states, "If we could get everyone on the same page, I think we would figure it out. These are issues that impact all of us." (paragraph 12). The ideas of the talent search finalists all support the main idea that climate change can slow down if people put their ideas and energy together to combat it.
