- ★ In Baltimore City, there are many things that can be recycled in single stream recycling.
- ★ At school, we are only recycling **CLEAN PAPER** and **CARDBOARD** in the classroom recycling bins.

Recycling at PPPCS

Classrooms will have the choice to opt into recycling through a google form. Classrooms that opt in will have a sign outside their classroom. This will notify facilities staff that you Green Team Ambassador handles your recycling. Your Green Team Ambassador will empty your bin into the large bin located in the basement. This will also serve as a reminder to your class to be mindful about sorting trash and recycling correctly.



If your class makes a mistake and puts trash in your bin, just empty the bin into the trash and try again.

If you do not opt in, your recycling bin will be removed and trash collection will continue as normals.

Things to remember:

- ★ Your blue recycling bin should not have a plastic liner.
- ★ Only put clean paper and cardboard in the blue recycling bin. *Please break down cardboard boxes.*
- ★ ALL other trash goes in the regular trash can including wipes, tissues, paper towels, and food waste.
- ★ Your bin will be emptied at the end of the day by your **Green Team Ambassador**.

In the basement of building 1, we also have recycling bins for:

- Markers, pencils, crayons, pens, and highlighters
- Plastic bags
- Plastic bottles
- Aluminum cans
- Small tech items like mice and headphones
